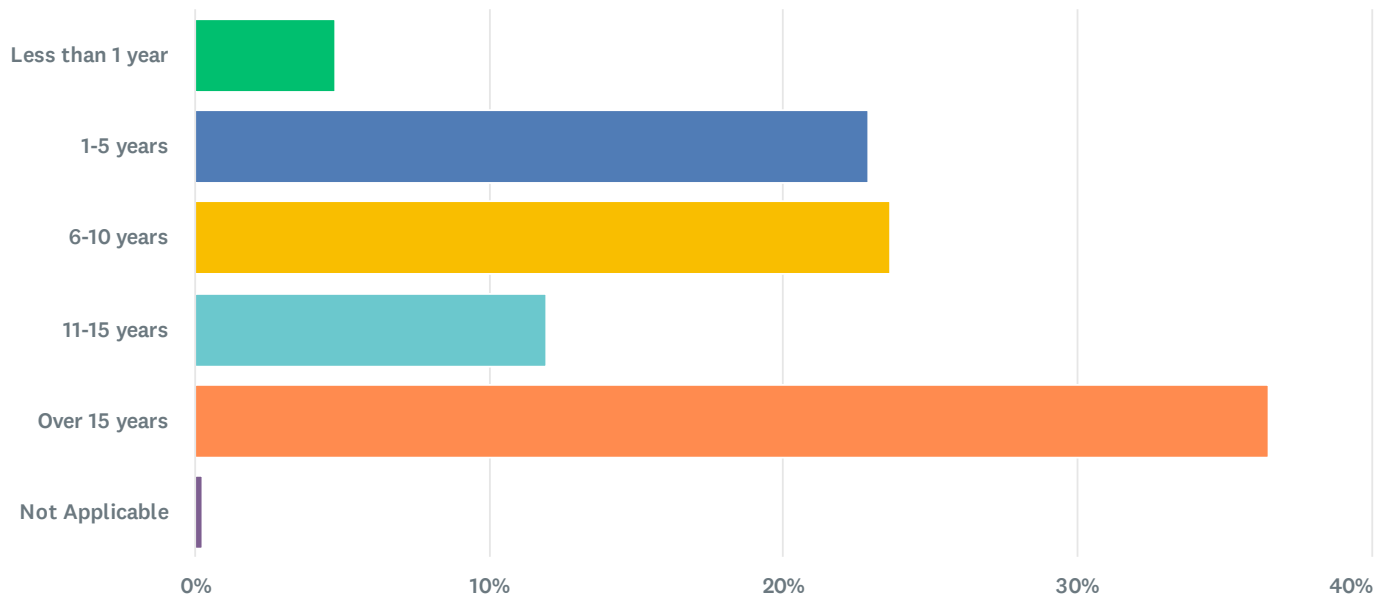

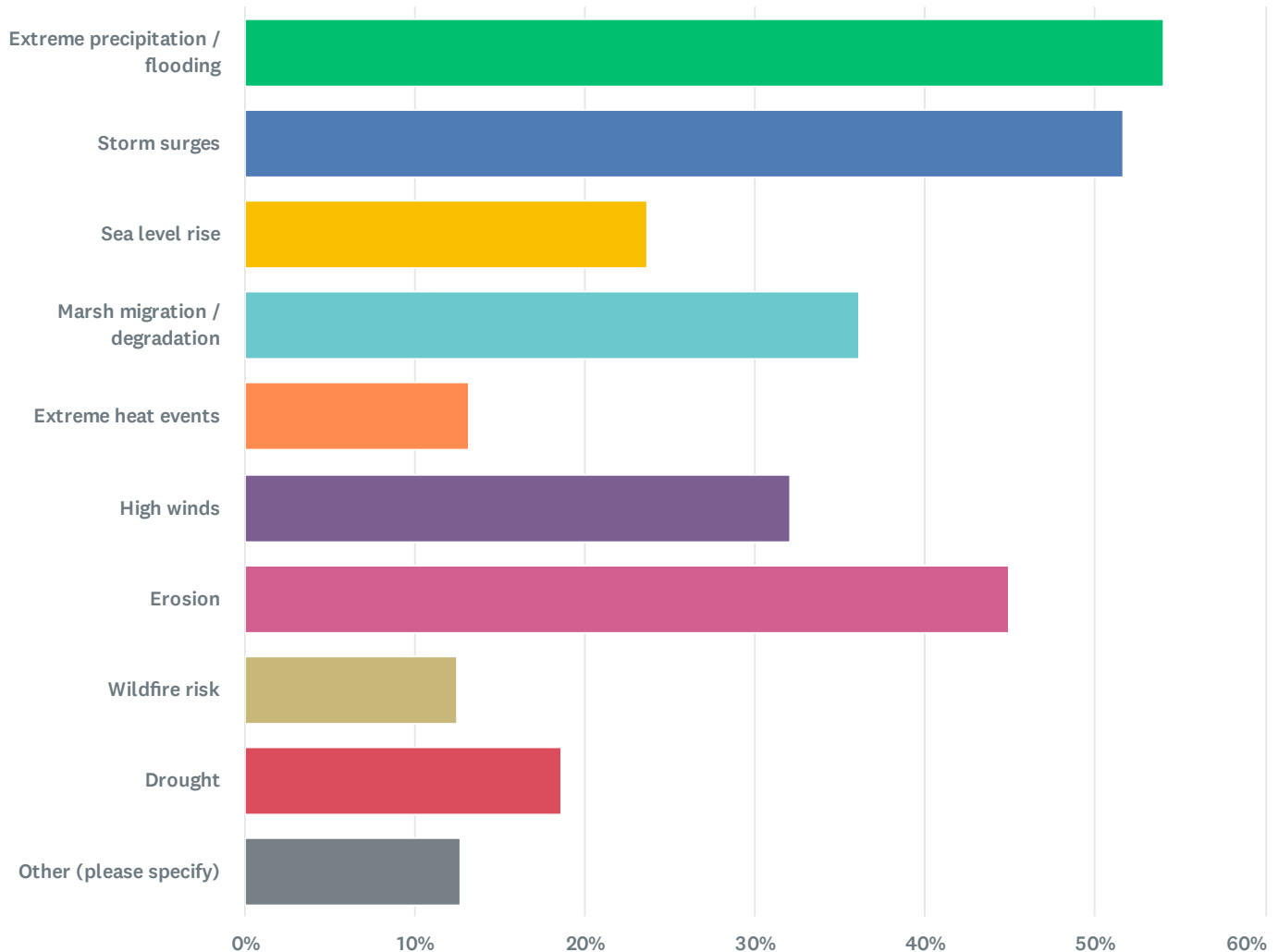

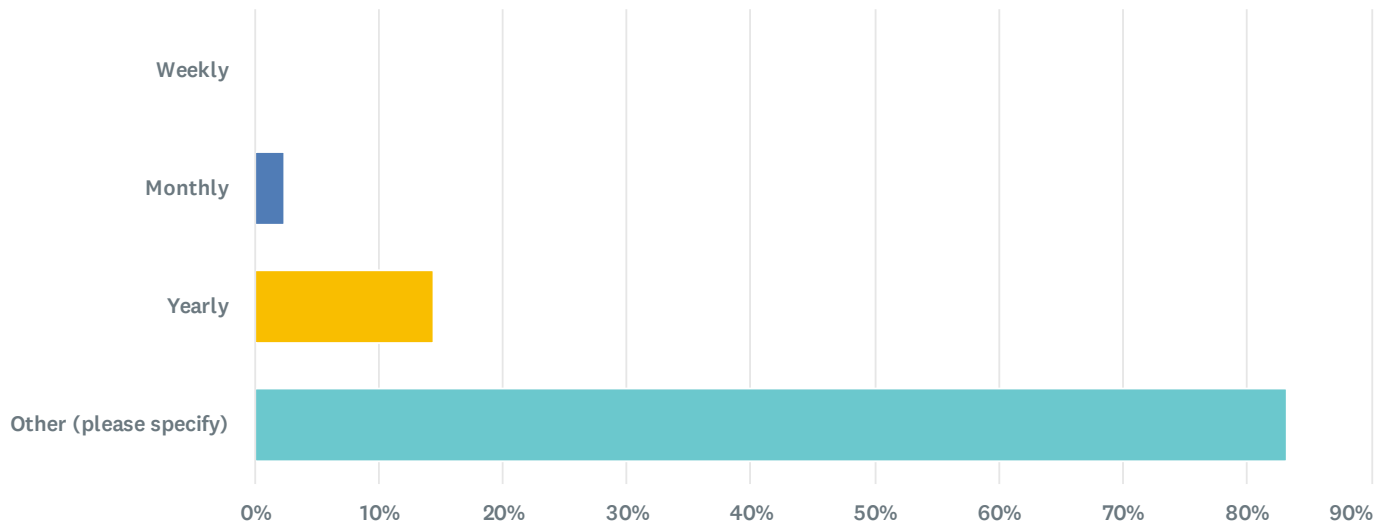

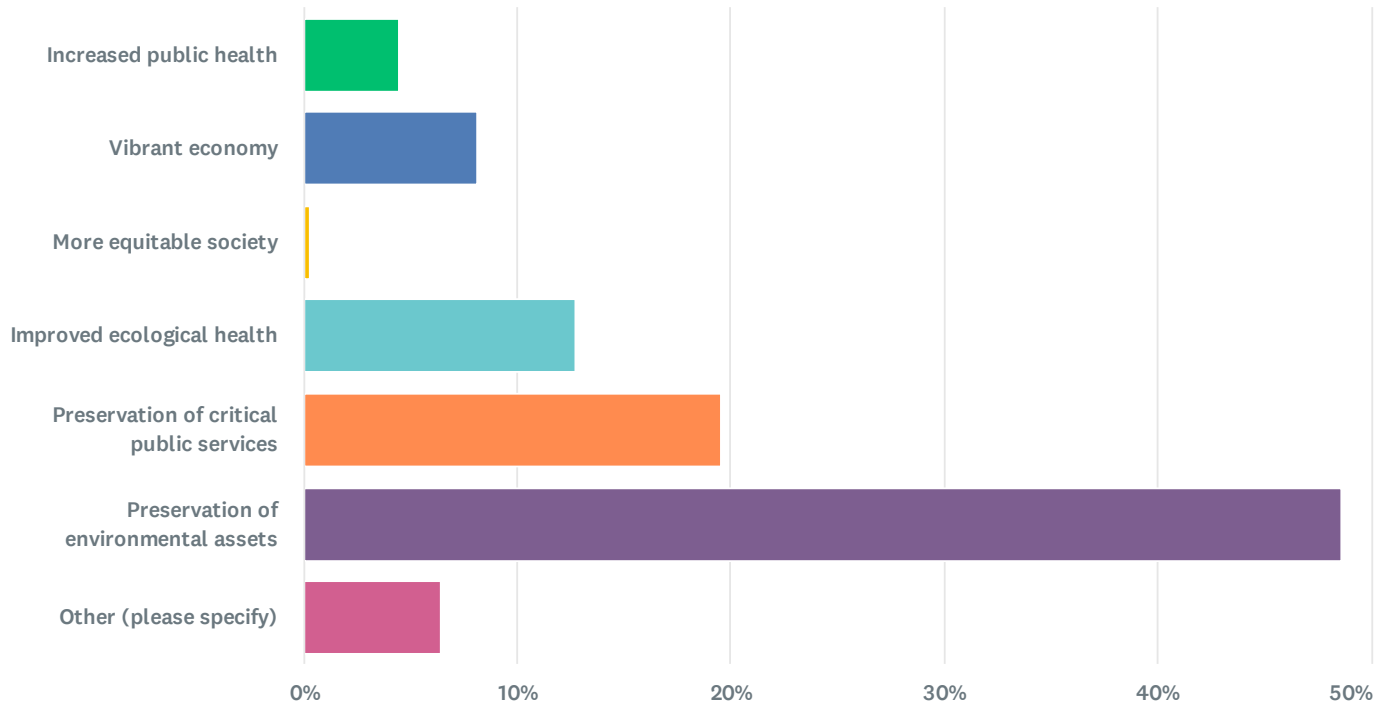

involvement will be required to complete the full on the ground inventory for comparison and verification of AI generated drone data at minimal cost to the town over several years time. The economic benefits of an annual \$3500 investment by the town in Tree inventory software eg (TreePlotter by Planit Geo) would be visible quickly in improved systems management. Staff ability to manage permitting jobs remotely improves staff efficiency. Faster assignment of staff improves customer service. Improved data for code enforcement and inspection fees, means improved revenue, less litigation and better enforcement of our ordinances. Decreased costs to the town for tree removal after storms is also a predicted result. Considering how to implement an Urban Forestry Management Plan which meshes seamlessly with software systems IT and GIS in all other town departments will be key to refining the interconnecting systems we need for full sustainable safety, readiness, response and recovery in the face of ongoing tree damaging storm events.
